- ❖ Initial site development for the 12 buildings
- ❖ Drainage
- ❖ Grading for drainage and site improvements (sidewalks, curbs and gutters, drive cuts)
- ❖ Utilities (water, sanitary, stormwater)
- ❖ Transportation design (ROW grading)

Wilson & Company's team of 12 volunteers assisted in the construction of the townhomes, Sable Ridge, in east Denver. Janalee Coyle organized the two-day event for the volunteers that to some was second nature, while others learned new skills, such as avoiding fingers when hammering a nail.

Other tasks the team worked on included: hanging doors, cutting footer for interior doors, sheathing, caulking, installing tie straps, framing doorways, hanging blue board insulation on the outside of a two story home, building a roof bump out for aesthetic appeal, and

bonding with our fellow co-workers, as well as the Habitat for Humanity/AmeriCorps team.

The event provided a successful way for us to work together, while not working behind our desks. It was a great opportunity to spend time with our co-workers and give back to the community.
