C Coalitions comprised of local, state, and federal agencies have been very successful in delivering transportation studies and improvement projects throughout the Colorado Front Range in recent years. Incorporating a variety of stakeholders, both at the technical and elected-official levels into the decision-making process has led to unified local agency support for transportation improvements. This support has proven key in securing funding for construction projects. Our presentation will highlight Wilson & Company's collaboration with, and assistance to, the C-470 Corridor Coalition in identifying a design solution, selecting a funding mechanism, leveraging local match dollars to secure construction funding, and coordination of parallel design and NEPA processes.
